

TOWN OF WALDEN  
TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 23 V.S.A. sections 1007 and 1008 and Title 24 V.S.A. Chapter 59 and such other enactments as may be material here to, the following Traffic Ordinance is adopted by the Walden Selectboard.

ARTICLE I. DEFINITIONS

The definitions in 23 V.S.A. Section 4 are incorporated by reference.

ARTICLE II. SCOPE

This Ordinance establishes special traffic regulations on public highways in the town of Walden.

ARTICLE III. SPEED REGULATIONS

Based on the public safety, neighborhood character, and characteristics of the highways the following speed limits are hereby established.

Section 1. - All unpaved roads hereby have a maximum speed of 35 m.p.h.

Section 2. - Route 215 from Route 15 to railroad tracks (0.3 miles) hereby has a maximum speed of 35 m.p.h.

Section 3. - Cabot Road from Route 15 to Houston Hill Road (0.8 miles) hereby has a maximum speed of 40 m.p.h.

ARTICLE IV. PENALTIES

This shall be a civil ordinance which shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions in Title 24 V.S.A. Chapter 59 or through a Vermont court having proper jurisdiction. The penalty for any violation shall be that set by the schedule of fines established by the State of Vermont

ARTICLE V. ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS

This ordinance may be enforced by any properly qualified law enforcement officer in the State of Vermont.


ARTICLE VI. SEVERABILITY


If any portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such finding shall not invalidate any other part of this ordinance.


ARTICLE VII. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective 60 days after its adoption by the Walden Selectboard. If petition is filed under 24 V.S.A. section 1973, that state shall govern the effective date.
